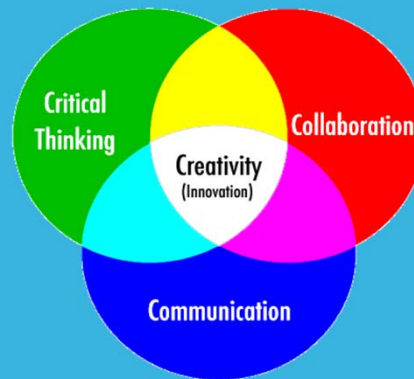

LIBRARY MEDIA SCHEDULE

Fixed Schedule – Teachers will bring whole groups following Week A/Week B Schedule.

Flexible schedule – Students are allowed to return and check books any time of day with permission from your teacher (signed hall pass).

Don't turn down corners of page, Use a bookmark to save your place.

Keep books in a safe, dry place; like a ziplock bag in your backpack.



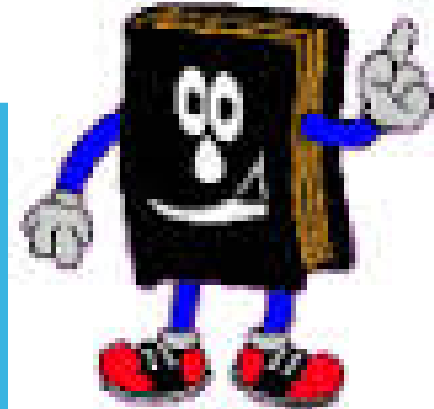
OVERDUES, FINES

No new book loans are permitted until overdue books are returned.

Lost books replacement fee varies per book.
