Bullock County Schools (BCS) will provide free breakfast and lunch to all BCS students, regardless of their economic eligibility, due to the district's continuing participation in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP).

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, allows qualifying high-need school districts to offer free breakfast and lunch to all students, providing the nutrition and energy children need to be healthy and ready to learn. CEP is a powerful tool that will assist in removing the stigma of the Free and Reduced Price meal program of the past.

Participating in the CEP program, allows Bullock County Schools Child Nutrition Program to receive full federal reimbursement for up to 100 percent of meals served. CEP has been successfully implemented in the district since 2015. As a result of our participation in CEP, the Child Nutrition Program has received increased revenues and decreased its dependence on the General Fund.

Bullock County Schools serves approximately 1400 students in 3 schools. During the 2017-2018 school year, we served 386,195 breakfast and lunch meals to our students free of charge.
