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2 Attendance

■Your child's attendance is required for his/her success in school and learning content material.

- Children must be present and on time for optimal learning experiences.
- ■100% of your child's attendance is under the watch care of parents.

Make-up doesn't always make-up for missed experiences in the classroom and learning activities.

Benefits of attending school regularly are endless.

3 Homework

Homework is...

- An essential tool for strengthening skills introduced; reinforcement of skills learned; remediation of skills not learned; and independent practice.
- Directly related to the classroom.
- ■An extension into the classroom and subject/course content.

Two Important Facts about Homework:

- Reading for a minimum of 20-30 minutes daily serves as an essential tool for students developing a love for reading, which impacts achievement.
- ♦Parents can assign homework too! Encourage it! Assign it too!

4 Collaborative Partnership

The Parent/Teacher Relationship is a powerful expression of support to your child, the teacher, and school.

This Collaborative Partnership requires:

Mutual goal: student success and achievement, which involves the education of the whole child.

- Two-way communication that is on going and continuous, not just when concerns arise.
- Openness; each party should be accessible and responsive to the other.

Visibility; student should recognize the partnership and be aware of it because it's a modeling tool for student/teacher relationship.

■Build your child's confidence

■Motivate your child to do his/her very best in all things

Communicate love, worth, and support to your child

Serve as an example for your child to model, even when things are not going as planned
