School Year 2022-2023

In accordance with guidelines set forth by the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE), Bullock County High School offers students who have failed courses required for graduation an opportunity to recover lost credit through Credit Recovery.

Credit Recovery is a standards-based approach that will target specific knowledge and skill deficits instead of requiring the student to repeat the entire course. Credit Recovery is based only on deficiencies and allows students to work on just the deficiencies to recover that credit for graduation.

Students must meet eligibility requirements to apply, and the Credit Recovery Program will be operated under the guidelines established by the ALSDE and the Bullock County Board of Education.

Students Eligible for Credit Recovery

- 1. Applications will be reviewed by a counselor to determine admittance into the Credit Recovery program.
- 2. Students are eligible for Credit Recovery if the final grade earned in a course required for graduation was from 40%-59% on a 100 point or equivalent scale. Students may choose to repeat the entire course during the next regular school term. (Students may also take the course in the traditional summer school format.)
- 3. Students who earned below 40% in a course required for graduation are **not** eligible for Credit Recovery and must repeat that course during the next regular school term (or attend BCBOE approved summer school).
- 4. Students who were absent more than ten (10) days (includes both excused and unexcused) in a course required for graduation are **not** eligible for Credit Recovery and must repeat that course during the next regular school term. Students may not recover credits lost due to absences.
- **5.** Students who have a record of substantial/major discipline infractions are **not** eligible for Credit Recovery.

Availability of Courses and Space

If space is currently unavailable, students will be placed on a waiting list and will be admitted into the course once a slot is vacant.

Credit Recovery Fee

A *NONREFUNDABLE* fee of \$125 must be paid in full by check or money order upon registration into Credit Recovery.

Credit Recovery Plan Components

Admission

Each student must complete a Bullock County High School Credit Recovery Application packet, which includes:

- 1. Parent/Student Information Flyer (Attachment A)
- 2. Credit Recovery Application for Admission/Registration (Attachment B)
- 3. Credit Recovery Student Agreement Sheet (Attachment C)
- 4. Credit Recovery Student Request Form (Attachment D)
- 5. Parent/Guardian Consent/Additional Information Form (Attachment E)

Removal

- 1. Three or more absences will result in removal from Credit Recovery course.
- 2. All students will comply with the rules set forth in the *Bullock County School System Code of Student Conduct*. Any infractions will result in removal from the program.

Attendance

All students enrolled in Credit Recovery are required to attend class for a minimum of two (2) weeks and must complete the course within six (6) weeks.

Schedule

Credit Recovery will be offered (as application numbers dictate):

• Monday-Thursday from 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m.

• Summer: Schedule TBD

Transportation

Parents/Students are responsible for transportation to and from the Credit Recovery Site.

Instruction

All Credit Recovery courses will be under the supervision of a Board-approved, certified teacher/facilitator.

1. Edgenuity will be the computer-based program students use to recover credits, thus, ensuring alignment with Alabama academic content standards approved by the Alabama State Board of Education.

Grades

- A maximum grade of 70% may be awarded in a Credit Recovery course provided students earn a class grade ranging from 60%-100%.
- The Credit Recovery grade will be entered on the student's transcript and designated by CR for Credit Recovery. That grade will be used for calculation of overall grade point average.
- The student's original failing grade will remain on his/her permanent record and will be used in calculation of overall grade point average.

- A maximum of 10 credits may be earned by a student in one school year including Credit Recovery course(s).
- The National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) does not recognize Credit Recovery for course credit.
- Criteria for awarding final grade for Credit Recovery course on transcript is designated in the table below.

Limitations

- 1. The National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) **does not** recognize Credit Recovery for course credit.
- 2. A maximum grade of 70% may be awarded in a Credit Recovery course in accordance with the Credit Recovery grading criteria.
- **3.** The student's original failing grade will remain on his/her permanent record and will be used in calculation of overall grade point average.

Credits

1. Credit Recovery courses in which students participate are to be included in calculating students' total credits for a school year.

- 2. Students may recover multiple credits if time permits. However, one (1) credit must be completed before attempting the next.
- 3. The Credit Recovery grade will be entered on the student's transcript and designated by CR for Credit Recovery.

**Exceptions for students with disabilities will be addressed by the student's IEP/504 committee.

CREDIT RECOVERY PARENT/STUDENT INFORMATIONAL FLYER BULLOCK COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL

<u>Audience</u>: Students who have failed a course required for graduation with a final grade between 40 and 59 with 10 or fewer absences and no substantial discipline issues. If the final average is below a 40 or credits lost due to absences, the student is not eligible for Credit Recovery.

- ***Credit Recovery **DOES NOT** meet the requirements for the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- *** If passed, a final grade of no greater than 70/C will be posted to the student's transcripts.
- *** The Credit Recovery grade will be entered on the student's transcript and designated by CR for Credit Recovery. That grade will be used for calculation of overall grade point average.
- ***The student's original failing grade will remain on his/her permanent record and will be used in calculation of overall grade point average.

Description:

This program will utilize computer-based instruction. Instruction will target specific remedial content standards in each academic subject area. Board approved, certified teachers/ facilitators will be used in core academic areas. Students must attend a minimum of two weeks and must be complete within six weeks to receive credit. Students may recover multiple credits during the term if time allows, but only one course at a time may be attempted. Students must receive approval via Credit Recovery Plan guidelines set forth by the Bullock County Board of Education.

Courses Offered:

Edgenuity course listing includes a list of available courses. (See counselor for this list.)

For Credit Recovery, you MUST speak with your counselor and have her sign off on your application.

You will then pay in the front office, and the forms will be turned in to the school's designee.

CREDIT RECOVERY AGREEMENT SHEET BULLOCK COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL

The Bullock County Board of Education has provided the opportunity for me to attend Credit Recovery at Bullock County High School. I understand that my enrollment is conditioned upon my willingness to follow Credit Recovery rules in addition to normal county/school policies.

Because Credit Recovery is an optional opportunity to recover lost credits, ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY!!!!

- Students will **not earn credit** and will be dismissed if they miss **more than THREE (3) days**.
- If a student is more than ten (10) minutes late to a class or if he/she checks out with more than ten (10) minutes remaining in the class, he/she will be counted absent for ½ day.
- Two (2) tardies will be counted as an office referral. After two office referrals, the 5th tardy will result in dismissal from Credit Recovery.
- If a student is withdrawn for attendance reasons, there will be NO REFUND!!!!
- Parents/students are responsible for transportation to and from the credit recovery site.

Because Credit Recovery is an optional opportunity, misbehavior will NOT be tolerated!

- All school rules outlined in the 2022-2023 Code of Student Conduct are in full affect. This
 includes, but is not limited to, dress code, possession of illegal substances, defiance and
 disrespectful behavior.
- Upon the first office referral (Class I or II offense), the student will be withdrawn from Credit Recovery.
- Students who drive to summer school must follow all rules regarding the use of personal vehicles on campus. The vehicle is subject to search for illegal substances and/or weapons.
- If a student is withdrawn for behavior reasons, there will be NO REFUND!!!

Other Items to Remember:

- Do not enter a classroom unless a teacher is present.
